HERBS - 3.5" POT
\$3.95 EACH

These are perennials and can remain planted over winter and will come back again on its own. Allow to continue to grow in pot before planting outside.

CATNIP

Your feline friend will love you when you bring them home some catnip! Plant in a place where you'll want to see it again next year. Catnip is in the mint family and can spread.

GARLIC CHIVES

Thin, flat leaves and delicate garlic flavor.

GERMAN THYME

Classic woody herb with small needle-shaped leaves. Can be used fresh or dried.

LEMON BALM

Take a sprig and stick in your water bottle for lemony flavor. Dry and steep in hot water for a tea. The most "local" lemon option. Grows big and bushy in the right conditions.

OREGANO

Strong aroma and flavor. Great for pizza and Italian cuisine.

MARJORAM

Aroma is similar to oregano but sweeter. Hints of pine and citrus.

SORREL

Lemony flavor and one of the first plants to emerge in the spring. Great with fish or use the first small leaves in salad.

SAGE

Wide variety of uses: dressings, sauces, sausage, or tea. Great in butternut squash soup. Woody plant.

CUCUMBER, PICKLING

Small classic cucumber great both fresh and pickled. Medium green skin and slightly tapered shape. 52 days

CUCUMBER, SLICING

Long, slender, 8-9" fruits. 58 days

GROUND CHERRY

Bushy plants grow 2-3' tall. When ripe, husk around fruit becomes papery dry and falls off plant. 75 days

HOT PEPPER, CAYENNE

Thin skinned fire engine red pepper, great for fresh eating, dried or powdered. 4-6" fruits. 60 days

HOT PEPPER, HOT WAX

Long banana-shaped waxy pepper. Turns from pale yellow to deep golden orange. Can be harvested at any stage but heat increases as peppers mature. 2-5" fruits. 60 days

HOT PEPPER, JALAPENO

Small moderately spicy pepper traditionally harvested green. Sturdy plants that do well in containers. 65 days

SUMMER SQUASH, YELLOW

Tender lemon-yellow fruits. Harvest at 5-6" long or smaller for best flavor. 50 days

SUMMER SQUASH, GREEN ZUCCHINI

Abundant yields of lightly mottled dark green fruits. 50 days

SWEET PEPPER

My very favorite sweet pepper variety, Carmen. Long and super sweet. Turns from green to red the longer it is on the plant. 75 days

CHERRY TOMATOES:

CHERRY TOMATO, MATT'S WILD CHERRY

Copious quantities of small, deep red cherries with exceptional flavor. 55 days

CHERRY TOMATO, MIDNIGHT PEAR

The outstanding flavor profile of this "black" tomato clearly earns Midnight Pear a place among the stars. 60 days

HEIRLOOM TOMATOES:

TOMATO, CHEROKEE GREEN

Medium-size, 8+ oz. green fruits acquire some yellowish-orange color on the blossom end when ripe. Lots of bold, acidic, complex tomato flavor. 72 days

TOMATO, GREAT WHITE

Large, creamy white fruit. This tomato is superbly wonderful. The flesh is so good and deliciously fruity, it reminds one of a mixture of fresh-cut pineapple, melon and guava. 75 days

TOMATO, PINK BRANDYWINE

Oblate meaty beefsteak fruits average right around a pound, ripening unevenly throughout the season, often preferring cool early fall to peak heat of August. 82 days

TOMATO, PRUDEN'S PURPLE*

Large to very large fruits are flattened, smooth and resist cracking. Vivid dark-pink skin with crimson flesh. 67 days

HYBRID TOMATOES:

TOMATO, BIG BEEF*

Classic red beefsteak tomato. 70 days.

TOMATO, RUTGERS*

Developed by Campbell Soup in 1928. Bred by Rutgers. 75 days.

BASIL, GENOVESE

Green glossy leaves, tender and sweet. 10-12" tall. 68 days

BOK CHOY

A Cloverleigh Farm favorite! Elegant vase-like shape. Medium thick stems and mild flavor. A must for any Asian-inspired dish. 50 days

GREEN BEANS

No need to start these from seed yourself in the garden. These transplants are ready to go in the ground! Pick beans when slender, before the beans inside the pod get large and the whole thing becomes starchy. 50 days

KALE, CURLY

Classic frilly leaf kale. 18" tall. Grows all season for continued harvest. 50 days

KALE, 'LACINATO' (DINOSAUR)

Heirloom. 30" tall, blue-green long thin leaves that sweeten with frost. Grows all season for continued harvest. 60 days

LETTUCE, HEAD (GREEN)

Heirloom variety called Pirat. Green tender heads tinged red. 55 days

LETTUCE, HEAD (RED)

Gorgeous red butterhead. A favorite variety called Alkindus. 52 days

NASTURTIUM, EMPRESS OF INDIA

Victorian era heirloom. Edible scarlet red flowers have a spicy kick. Great for salads, egg dishes, or just to look pretty! 1.5' tall and wide. Likes cooler weather of early fall too. 70 days

SWISS CHARD, RAINBOW

Blend of beautiful colors. Definitely one of the most striking crops on the farm. Easy to harvest. Grows all season for continued harvest, cutting individual stems. 60 days

FENNEL

Crisp & juicy. Sweet and mild anise flavor with a texture similar to celery. Very fun for kids. So refreshing on a hot day! 80 days

SCALLION

Small white onion, dark green tops, uniform growth. Very versatile in the kitchen. Use raw or grill them for real deliciousness. 65 days

CALENDULA PACIFIC CREAM BEAUTY

Colors of creamy yellows couple with a very special calendula fragrance. Can be used medicinally and in lotions. 12"-16" tall



SALVIA CLARY BLUE

A favorite in cottage gardens, this annual salvia has papery purple bracts in a spire, that last for a long time in the garden. Great paired with poppies.



COSMOS 'FARMER'S CHOICE'

For reasons unknown, cosmos had very poor germination this spring. Varieties are mixed and in short supply. Colors of white, pink, and fuschia are all options - exciting to see what you will get! 3-5' tall depending on sunlight and soil conditions.



ZINNIA LILAC EMPRESS

Huge violet-purple flowers with tousled petals bloom all season long. Attractive to butterflies.



POPPY AMAZING GRAY

Lavender grey tissue papered petals are a showstopper. Thrive in fertile well-drained soil. Tendency to self-seed. 1.5-2' tall



ZINNIA LUMINOSA

Heirloom zinnia that first appeared in seed catalogs in the 1930s. Deep pink color.



POPPY PANDORA

Unusual poppy that combines vibrant shades of pink to red to burgundy with silvery stripes. So gorgeous. Tendency to self-seed. 1.5-2' tall



ZINNIA SCARLET FLAME

Beautiful red color that butterflies love, especially Monarchs. As with all zinnias, pinch top once seedlings are 6" tall to encourage bushiness.
